Practice Analytics Overview

Reports

Deep dive, detailed analysis of specific data points. Often with a narrative component.



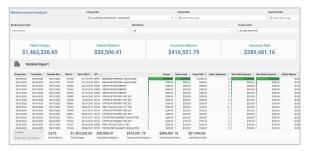
Financial Analytics

Overview of key metrics and trends for quick monitoring and decision-making.



Benchmarks

Compare performance to industry standards or peers to spot strengths and weaknesses.







What is Benchmarking?

Definition:

A standard or point of reference (in this case, pediatric-specific data) against which things may be compared or assessed (against other OP practices).

Purpose:

To improve organizational performance by comparing key metrics, processes, and practices against industry leaders or best-in-class companies to identify performance gaps, adopt best practices, and set realistic goals for continuous improvement.

Benchmarking is used to help businesses understand their competitive standing, **boost** efficiency and productivity, reduce costs, foster innovation, and ultimately enhance customer satisfaction and overall success.

Filling the Gap in Pediatric Metrics

Filling a need:

- Pediatric-specific metrics are scarce
- MGMA data are not specific to pediatrics
- Pediatric Benchmarking aggregates data from all OP EHR customers
- Results are truly pediatric-specific

Why this is useful:

- Informative comparisons can be made with other like practices
- KPI comparisons available on a local, regional, or national scale
- Evaluations help influence important decision-making
- Identify areas of strength and weakness for both the care side and the business side of your practice



Your patients are unique — so are your benchmarks

Don't settle for average, surface-level benchmarks.

Pediatric Benchmarking is ideal for:

- Healthcare leaders who want deeper insights to run smarter and more profitably.
- Physicians and practice owners ready to improve efficiency and revenue at the same time.
- Administrators, C-suite, CPAs, and operations managers who want benchmarks that drive real decisions, not just data points.

Comparisons for 13 KPIs Available Today

Benchmarking results available today:

- Financial metrics encompassing receivables, revenue, payments, and scheduling
- All metrics are
 - Aggregated and de-identified
 - Reported at the practice level
- Every OP practice is represented
- 5th and 95th percentile thresholds reported

Near-Term Roadmap Additions

Double the Count of KPI Metrics

- Diagnostic Vaccination Rates
- Diagnostic Patient Mix and Engagement
- Financial Charges and Claims
- Expand initial categories, such as
 - Revenue % of All Charges
 - Schedule Fill to Vacancy Ratio

Add New Time-Bound Dimension

Users can see how their percentiles have changed over time (starting with 8/1/25)

Add Provider-Level Detail

 Users can see individual providers' KPI achievements against nationwide providers for applicable KPIs
